Lobby

The expansive lobby provides a friendly welcome to visitors and residents. The new lobby features a digital display, space for art exhibits, and book displays.



Café

The Cafe, conveniently located in the center of the Library adjacent to the Lobby, features healthy vending options and an inviting gathering space.



New Materials

New fiction, new non-fiction, "hot" picks, movies, music, and video games are located in this "marketplace" area on the first floor for quick convenience and browsing.



Study Rooms

Study rooms are popular and book up fast, so the number of study rooms have been increased from eight to fifteen, with several single-person study rooms. All new rooms feature whiteboards and a digital monitor for projecting.



Quiet Reading Room

This popular space captures the serenity of the pond view and provides an exclusive reading area. The Quiet Reading Room is located on the second floor apart from nosier, active areas.



Meeting Rooms

These three digitally equipped meeting rooms of various sizes are used for the numerous meetings and programs scheduled each day. The Library hosts 1,400 programs a year with an attendance of over 39,000 children, teens, and adults.

Adult Collection

The adult collection, fiction and non-fiction, are located on the second floor, creating a generally quieter atmosphere, reserving more social activities for the first floor.

Board Room

New acoustic panels update this room that is also available as a meeting room.

Elementary Learning Space

A new open space for school-age children features interactive activities that inspire creativity and employ fun while learning.



Early Literacy Area

The updated younger children's area includes developmentally appropriate collections, play areas, and learning opportunities for toddlers and preschoolers.

Storytime/Program Rooms

These new children's programming rooms include an updated look, a digital monitor, and a kitchenette for enhanced activities.



Sensory/Nursing Room


This new room features frosted windows, white noise, and a locking door for privacy for nursing mothers. Sensory bins containing noise-cancelling headphones, manipulatives, and a weighted mat are included to promote calming strategies for those experiencing sensory overload.

Teens

Teen Space

This special partially enclosed area covering over 2,000 square feet is designated just for teens for studying and group work. A gaming section offers video game consoles for teens to play together.





Makerspace

The Workshop

This space is intended to inspire members to express their creativity, to work on projects, and design whatever they can imagine with equipment they may not have access to already. Computers, audio/video recording equipment, and new resource tools for self-led and collaborative creation are a great benefit to entrepreneurs, artists, crafters, and novices of all ages. Among the many resources included: 3D printers, laser cutter, cameras, microphones, sewing machines, button maker, heat press, die cut press, various hand tools, and much more! Programs and classes are held in the working lab also in this area.





Total Makerspace Area is 4600 square feet. Digital Media Studios and Collaborative Rooms also available for naming opportunities.



Donor Levels and Recognition
