### Literacy Tip:



## **Baby Likes Bugs!**

Opening Song: **Hello Baby** Hello, baby! Hello, baby! Hello, baby! It's time to say hello!

Read Aloud: **Bumble Bugs and Elephants** by Margaret Wise Brown

#### Action Rhyme: "The Insects and Spiders"

(Tune: The Wheels on the Bus)

The pretty butterflies fly up and down, up and down, up and down (*flap arms like wings*)

The pretty butterflies fly up and down, all through the day! (*flap arms like wings*)

The spiders in the tree all spin a web, spin a web, spin a web... (*roll arms*)

The spiders in the tree all spin a web, all through the day! (*roll arms*)

The crickets in the field hop up and down (3x)... (bounce baby)

The bees in the hive go buzz, buzz, buzz. (3x).. (fly with arms out)

#### Song: The Itsy Bitsy Spider

The itsy-bitsy spider went up the waterspout. Down came the rain and washed the spider out! Out came the sun and dried up all the rain, And the itsy-bitsy spider went up the spout again!

#### Action Song: Caterpillar, Caterpillar

(Tune: Are You Sleeping?)

Caterpillar caterpillar (*Wiggle fingers of one hand*) In the tree, in the tree (*Spread arms like branches*) First you wiggle this way (*Wiggle hand left*) Then you wiggle that way (*Wiggle hands right*) Look at me, look at me (*Point to self*) Read Aloud: Ten Little Ladybugs by Melanie Gerth

#### Action Song: Open Shut Them

Open, shut them. Open, shut them. Give a little clap, clap, clap! Open, shut them. Open, shut them. Put them in your lap, lap, lap.

Creep them, creep them, creep them, right up to your chin!

Open wide your smiling mouth, but do not let them in! Creep them, creep them, creep them, creep them past your cheeks and chin.

Open wide your smiling eyes. Peeking in, boo!

Creep them, creep them, creep them, right down to your toes.

Let them fly up in the air, and BOP you on the nose! *Repeat first two lines.* 

#### Nursery Rhyme: Little Miss Muffet

Little Miss Muffet sat on a tuffet, Eating her curds and whey. (*sign for "eat" - fingers to mouth*) Along came a spider who sat down beside her, (*walk fingers up baby's arm*) And frightened Miss Muffet away! (*tickle*!)

Bounce Song: I'm a little beetle (Tune: I'm a little teapot)

I'm a little beetle And I wiggle all day If you get too close to me, I'll FLY away! I'm a little bumblebee... I'm a little ladybug...

#### Closing: Goodbye Song
