them past your cheeks and chin.

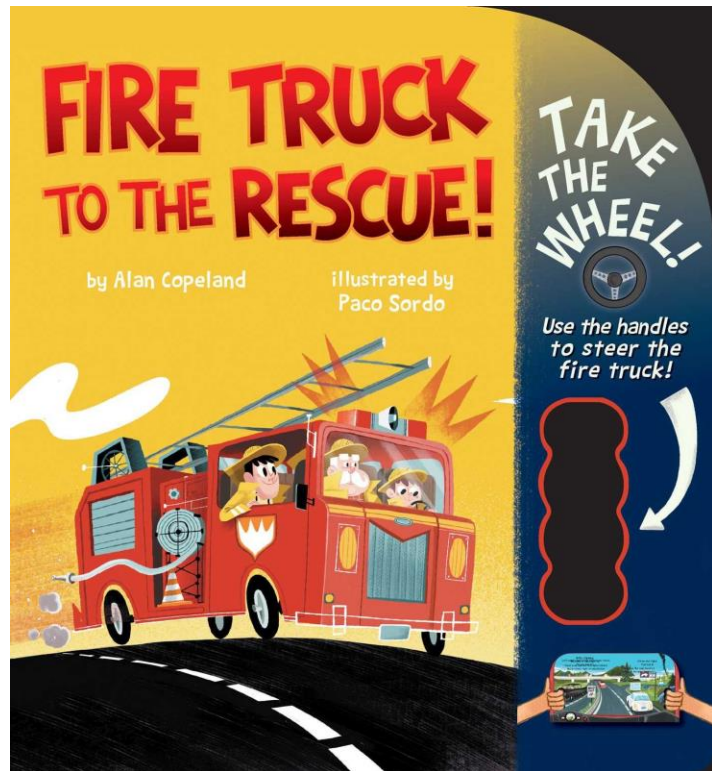
Open wide your smiling eyes. Peeking in, boo!

Read Together



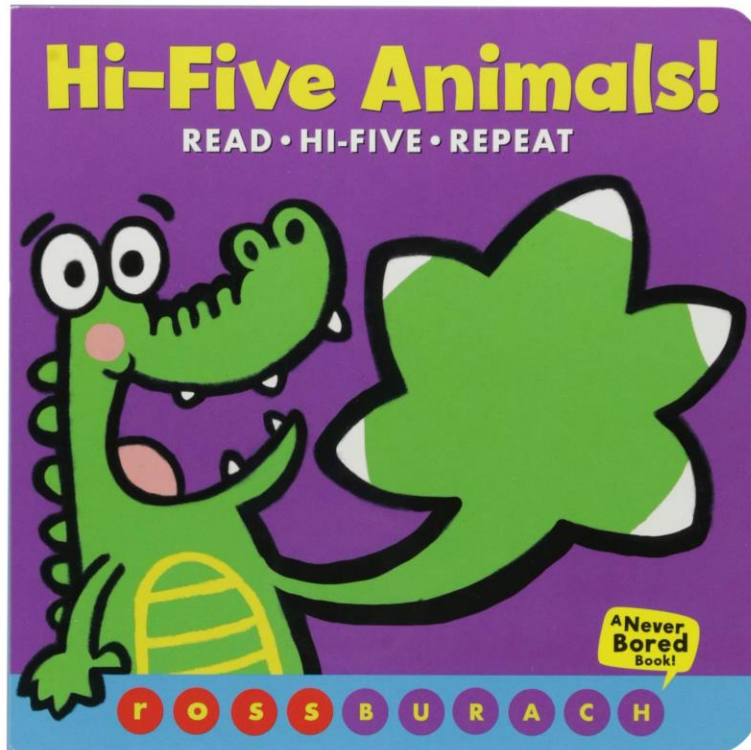
Lap Bounce: Bouncing,

(Lift on 3)

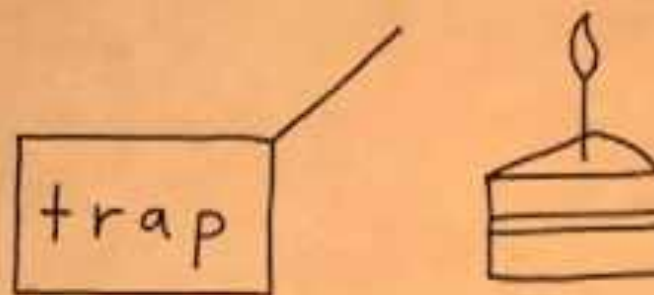
*Repeat with clapping,

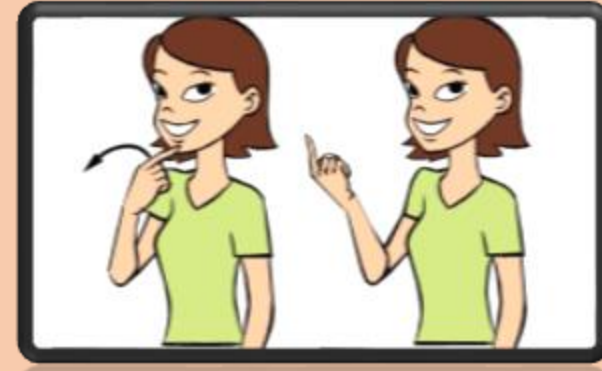
