





Creep them, creep them, creep them, creep them past your cheeks and chin.


Open wide your smiling eyes. Peeking in, boo!


Creep them, creep them, creep them, creep them, right down to your toes.

### Lap Bounce: Bouncing, Bouncing Baby on My Knee


Bouncing, bouncing Baby on my Knee Bouncing, Bouncing 1. 2. 3. *(Lift on 3)*
